
Church History

- 1865 Today (154 years!)
- <u>One Hundred Years of Fayetteville (1828-1928)</u> and the account of Pearly Blye.
- Campbell records that there was a man named Matthew Leeper who owned more than 300 slaves. One of his slaves, **Squire Jehegen**, after being freed became a Baptist preacher and later organized a church (Saint James Missionary Baptist)
- Our namesake two churches
- 14 Pastors
- 40 to 1100+ members

The Scriptures

We believe that the Bible is the inspired word of God. The Bible brings the revealed Word of God as the ground and foundation from which all claims of truth shall be substantiated.

The scriptures are the supreme and final authority.

(2 Timothy 3:16-17; Hebrews 4:12; Peter 1:20-21)



We believe that there is only one and true living God existing in three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit! Each a distinct Person, but having the same nature, perfection and attributes.

(Genesis 1: 1-3, 26; Matthew 3:16-17; 28:19; John 1:1, 14; John 10:30, John 14:26, John 15:26)



Jesus Christ

We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God; the only begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, shed his blood on Calvary in our place, was buried, rose again and ascended to heaven to sit at the right hand of the Father according to the scriptures.

(Luke 1:26-33; 22:20; 24:46)

Holy Spirit

We believe that the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, God coexists with the Father and Son. The Holy Spirit is the Chief Agent in the regeneration of the soul, Chief Convictor of sin, and the Chief Comforter of the believer. The Holy Spirit baptizes the believer into the body of Christ and is the giver of ALL spiritual gifts.

Man

We believe that man is the direct creation of God - body, soul, spirit. Therefore, man is not in any way a result of evolution, but is made in God's image. The sin and fall of Adam resulted in the fall of creation and mankind both spiritually and physically.

(Genesis 1:26-27; Romans 3:10; Romans 5:12; Romans 8:18-23)

Salvation

We believe that all who, in faith, receive the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior born again by the Holy Spirit and thus becomes the children of the living God. Salvation involves redemption, regeneration, sanctification and glorification.

(John 17:16-22; Romans 10:9-10; 1Corinthians 6:19; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Colossians 1:13-14, 21-22)

Eternal Security

We believe that salvation is not only a gift from God but is sustained by Him as well. Salvation is wholly of the Lord, apart from the works of man. The Holy Spirit permanently indwells the true believer and seals him in salvation for eternity. Therefore, the believer shall be kept by the power of God through faith.

- 4. As your faith grows and your gifts are developed we encourage you to <u>engage in one of our many ministries</u>.




Step 3: Win

- 7. Submit to the leadership of elders (Heb 13:17)
- 8. Share the good news of Jesus with those in their life (Matt 28:19-20)




Benefits of Members

- 4. It places them under the <u>spiritual protection</u> of godly leaders (Heb 13:17; Acts 20:28-29)
- 5. It gives them the <u>accountability</u> they need to grow (Eph 5:21)

Also, as a member of St. James you are invited to attend church business meetings where you can vote on important matters such as the church budget, major building projects, etc.



- Use the SOAP Bible Study Method


