# TITLE: Director of Music and Arts (Part-time)

## POSITION REPORTS TO: Senior Pastor

## **Summary of Position:**

The Historic Saint James Missionary Baptist Church seeks a Christian, collaborative professional to execute, oversee and direct the Music and Arts Ministry. The objective is to create a collaborative ministry that provides a spirit-filled worship experience through the arts. This is a parti-time position and will report to the Senior Pastor.

#### Job Qualifications:

- Personal and family life consistent with Christian Biblical Principles
  - Must be a Bible believing Christian (preferably a member of The Historic St. James or commit to joining within 60 days)
- Must be theologically sound and ascribe to churches vision, mission, and beliefs
- This person will have either formal education (preferred) or proven experience and personal study necessary to perform all the various aspects of this ministry.
- An intimate, dynamic, life-changing, growing relationship with God. It is expected that this person will be continually seeking to grow in his knowledge and his relationship with Christ.
- A passion for the Bible: This person will be someone who knows the truth of Scripture well, has a developed understanding of Scripture and a passion to have the Word of God known.
- A passion for the lost: This person will be able to convey the need to be fulfilling the Great Commission as well as the Great Commandment.
- A passion for prayer: This person will set the tone for prayer within the music and worship arts ministry.
- A passion for discipleship: This person will have the desire to see us raising up disciples who are making disciples and to aid in creating a culture that embraces this.
- Must be a self-starter, proactive to take on projects, independent thinker, work well without instruction and can lead
- Must have a caring attitude, excellent people skills and high integrity
- Faithfulness, confidentiality, and a strong sense to serve others are essential
- Must have an in depth understanding of all genres of Christian music and can teach it with excellence to the musicians and choirs.
- Must have strong verbal and written communications skills
- Must be able to work collaboratively with all church ministries
- Available for work outside normal working hours during the week
  - Be accessible, responsive, and flexible to handle the changing needs of the church
- Must be flexible and able to respond consistently in an interrupt driven environment

#### **MINISTRY DUTIES:**

To provide overall musical direction, organization, and leadership for worship that will set the atmosphere for intentional worship. Specific duties will include the following:

- 1. Be responsible for direct oversight of all Music, Band, Liturgical Dance, and Choirs to include: Mass, Men and Youth Choirs, Praise Team, musical selections, musicians; recruitment, rehearsals, Dance teams and performances at the regularly scheduled services and special events.
- 2. Must be able to teach parts and melody to ensure the quality of singing is of excellence and honoring God to include a combination of tradition, contemporary and hymns.
- 3. Be responsible for assuring that those participating in the music ministry are adequately prepared and that the music selected is appropriate.
- 4. Build a competent team and coordinate the worship planning and implementation of a comprehensive music ministry for the congregation and community.
- 5. Be responsible for assuring that the musical instruments used by the church are kept in good working order.
- 6. Oversee and guide the arrangement of workshops, concerts, or guest appearances by musical groups from St. James at other churches or in specialized ministries.
- 7. Promote the spiritual life of the congregation through the music ministry in corporate worship.
- 8. Be familiar with the mission, vision, and overall goals of the church vision and how they influence the worship experience.
- 9. Responsible for Music and Arts budget to include preparing yearly budgets, managing expenses.
- 10. Must be able to travel periodically on church ministry trips.
- 11. Must be able to recruit and retain musicians and singers, as necessary.
- 12. Keep the Pastor posted on all matters pertaining to the Music and Arts Ministry both internal and external.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

• Bachelor's degree in music or seven years of leading a church music department.
